I think the most famous chapter in the Bible read and used about women is *Proverbs 31*. It's a fabulous chapter, however, I wonder if sometimes a woman can read it and feel a little bit inadequate. Let's face it; this Proverbs 31 woman is incredible! She does everything in an amazing way, is an exemplary wife and mother who needs little sleep, works inside and out-side the home, and never puts her lovely foot out of place.

But actually, I believe that the *Proverbs 31* woman is in fact a reminder of how much a woman should be valued. It's a description of the many and varied callings and responsibilities beautifully executed by women. The passage begins by calling her worth "above Rubies" and ends by saying she should be praised and able to enjoy the fruit of her hands.

God has always placed high value on women, and great trust; we should follow His lead. In His Word, I see women:

- entrusted with great responsibility (Elizabeth, Mary)
- who did great exploits (Deborah, Jael with her tent peg)
- whose wisdom and courage saved lives (Esther, Abigail)
- whose faith impacted generations (Lois and Eunice)

Women... if ever you feel inadequate, and we can all have those moments, remember God has already called your worth and no person can change that.

And men... remember to follow God's lead and value the women in your world every day.


